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Payments on accounts are due by the 10th of each month. The City Clerk is directed to send notices to all customers who have not paid their utility bills by the 10th of the month notifying such consumers of the total amount of utility bills then owed; and advising them that if said bills are not paid in full by the 20th of each month utility service will be disconnected. If the total amount due for such utilities and service is not paid in full on or before the deadline established, and the City records show that the consumer has had due notice of the billings then the City Clerk shall cause such service to be discontinued.

A reconnection charge for utilities disconnected due to delinquency shall be \$75.00 plus tax.

UTILITIES DISCONNECTED FOR THIS REASON WILL BE CHARGED AN ADDITIONAL \$40.00 TO BE RECONNECTED ON SATURDAYS, SUNDAYS, HOLIDAYS OR AFTER NORMAL WORKING HOURS. (4:00 P.M.)

ANY AND ALL DEBTS OWED THE CITY MUST BE PAID BEFORE SERVICE WILL BE ESTABLISHED.

All outstanding utility bills must be paid prior to establishing service at another address.

The City shall collect a utility deposit in the amount of \$150.00.

Discontinuance of service can occur for the following:

- 1) Failure to pay when due.
- 2) Violation of City Ordinances, Resolutions or departmental rules.
- 3) Unsafe conditions.
- 4) Tampering, bypassing or unauthorized metering.
- 5) Subterfuge.
- 6) Denying utility right access to the premises.

Each person of legal age who resides at a premise shall be deemed to have received the benefit of utility service supplied and shall be liable to the City for payment whether or not the service is listed in that person's name.
